## **Responsibilities:**

- Demonstrating/teaching specialized strategies and/or providing topical workshops.

## **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Master's degree in special education with an emphasis in technology **OR** a bachelor's degree in special education and suitable experience.
- Experience providing training regarding autism spectrum disorders and related interventions.
- Knowledge of current research and a range of practices in the field of autism.
- Recent experience working in the field of autism.
- Flexibility and willingness to learn new skills.
- Ability to travel independently in rural/remote Alaska.
- Experience working with learners who experience print disabilities.

- Demonstrated experience in training professionals, paraprofessionals, and community members.
- Interagency networking and collaboration.
- Experience in developing and implementing communication-based support strategies.
- Knowledge of Positive Behavior Supports.
